Jason was teaching confirmation and mapped out what a week of mission work in Lynchburg would look like. The week will be June 22-26. The day will start at 8am meeting at Peakland for announcements and prayer. From 8:30-12:30 we will work with InterFaith Rebuilds (formerly Rebuilding Together). They are working on projects for us from painting to building ramps. There will be a lunch break from 12:30-2pm at Peakland. The youth who met felt like it was important for us to do smaller



projects that wouldn't take a whole day or week to spread the love around Lynchburg. So, from 2:30-4:30pm each afternoon, we will work with some other non-profit or ministry in the community. We will return to Peakland for dinner from 5-6:30pm, which will be followed by an hour of debriefing and theological reflection on the day. We will end each day by 7:30pm. Youth will go home to shower and sleep and return the next day to do it all over again!
