

every other week, replacing the church's recycling steward program. You will notice that there are new beige bins (replacing the blue plastic bags) in the kitchen and the Preschool hallway. Place church recyclables in those inside bins.

The GREAT news is now we do not sort the items and Waste Solutions takes the following:

Aluminum: cans, trays, foil, siding

Metal: Tin cans, aluminum cans, all light iron scrap

Glass: Soda, water, beer, liquor only. (NO plate glass, window shield glass or ceramics)

Plastic: #'s 1-7, Styrofoam, milk and juice bottles or jugs, laundry detergent and softener bottles, rigid

plastics, shrink-wrap, plastic bags, bubble wrap and children's rigid plastic play sets, trikes, etc.

Cardboard: Moving boxes, empty pizza boxes, empty food or cereal boxes, packing boxes, delivery

boxes, divider strips, and case containers.

Magazines, Catalogs, & Phone books

Mixed Paper: Newspapers, flyers and inserts, office paper and junk mail.

Wood: All natural, un-treated, unpainted wood pieces & scraps, 2x4s, 4x4s, pallets, etc.
